COVID-19

Dear Member

With the ongoing issue globally surrounding the Coronavirus (COVID-19), in conjunction with official guidance from Tennis Australia, NSCC are issuing the following guidelines for all of us to follow. The hygiene poster and other relevant material will be displayed at the club for members and guests to read and are updated when required or as the situation and official guidance around the situation develops.

Please use the SAFE WA app when entering the facilities.

Our response as a club to the unprecedented COVID-19 situation is that we will be **'alert not alarmed'**, and we will be monitoring every development and follow government guidelines or direction given.

With regard to all club activities, including Tennis, we will adhere to the government guidelines which, at this stage **only** precludes people who are sick, in contact with virus patients, or who have travelled from high risk countries, from attending public places. Until we are advised otherwise, our activities will continue as planned. Should public health advice and this position change, we will update our guidance immediately.

What we are doing:

1. Remaining aware and up to date monitoring advice from the Health Department and any communications of any relevant information from our club network and affiliated associations.
2. All scheduled tennis whether social or tournaments (both host and attending) will be monitored on a case-by-case basis and will continue until advised otherwise.

What we ask from you as a club member:

1. If you present with any cold, flu or fever symptoms please do **NOT** attend the club or any club events and seek medical advice.
2. We encourage all members and visitors to practice good hygiene – please follow our information as displayed at the club where we aim to have hand sanitizer combined with our hand washing facilities readily available at the club.
3. At this moment we consider it safe to do so, and will continue with all planned club activities, but we advise all our members and visitors to practice good hygiene, and advise anyone who is feeling unwell, has had contact with infected individuals, or has travelled to any high risk countries to please avoid attending the club or any associated club events.
4. Please advise others you know about the guidance as it currently stands.

And finally, here is some extra advice for those who may have travelled recently ...

As per guidelines from the Health Department, we request that all members or their guests and players who have travelled outside of Western Australia do **not** attend our club or club events in line with the Government and Public Health Authority guidelines at the time.

Our number one priority is the safety of our community, and we will continue to keep you informed as more information comes to light. Things can move and change quickly and we will inform you of any updates as quickly as is practicable.
