COVID GUIDELINES

NSCC COVID GUIDELINES

Following the government mandate and directions, effective from Monday 31st January 2022 the following restrictions / guidelines will apply to the North Shore Country Club:

- Masks are mandatory inside unless eating or drinking and will be worn for service at the bar or kiosk
- Proof of Vaccination status against COVID-19 is required by all those 16 years and over by way of government approved evidence to enter and remain:
 - o Digital certificate of vaccination or exemption on ServiceWA app
 - o Digital or printed certificate of vaccination or exemption plus secondary photo ID

(This includes North Shore clubhouse, grounds, and facilities. However, the use of the courts for organised or casual use, including coaching and pennants, are exempt from proof of vaccination for playing purposes and its duration only.)

- Mandatory check-in using either **SafeWA** or **ServiceWA** apps, or manual sign in on our register
- Maintain social distancing where possible

- Members of North Shore once identified as providing 'proof of vaccination' or exemption will be issued with marker on their membership card by the club. This will limit the frequency of providing proof.
- This marker on their membership card will be the necessary evidenced used at the bar or kiosk for service.
- For those members who may not have a card for any reason, the club will issue a new one, having identified membership, and 'proof of vaccination'.
- For all visitors to the club, it is envisaged we will employ a temporary identification marker to denote 'proof of vaccination' whilst using the facilities at North Shore and entrance into the clubhouse.
- Signage will be employed around the facility to remind members and visitors of the requirement to meet the mandates from government.
- We will continue to review these guidelines as and when government directions change and where we feel it is practical to meet the directions of government.
